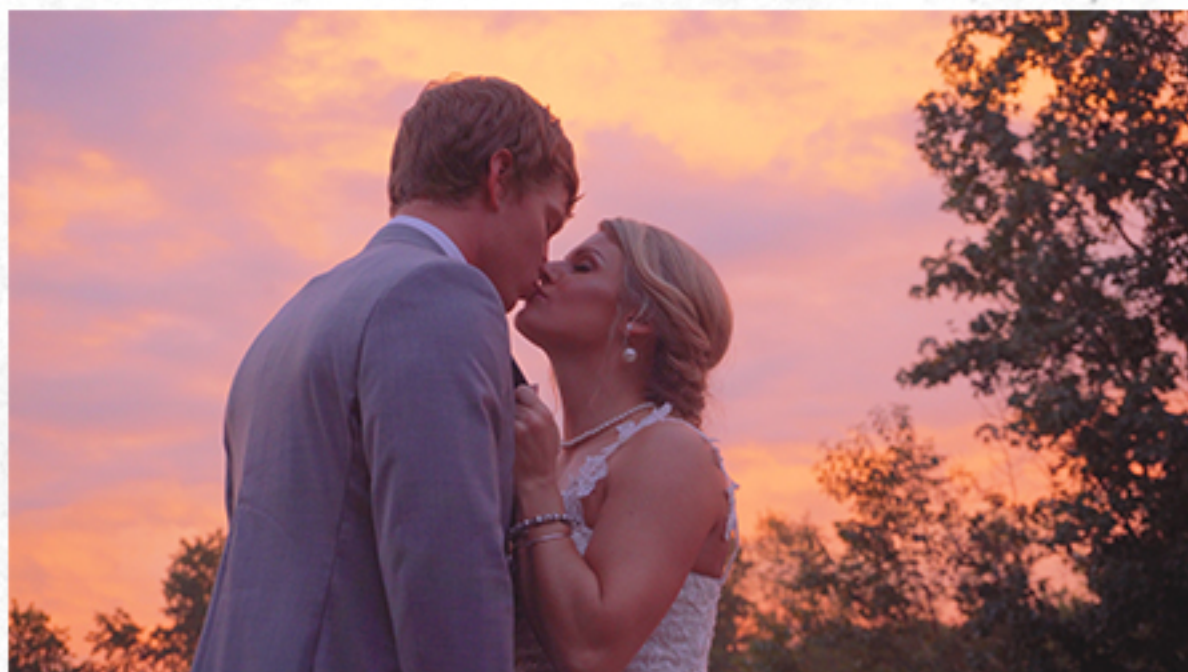

Love Story Film

This is an 8-10 minute interview style video. We film each of you separately, asking you questions from your first date, to the proposal, to who is the worst driver! We

then edit the footage into a sweet and humorous video about you both. We can even add hand drawn animations to reenact funny stories!

Vintage Highlight Film

Similar to Super8 film, we use a small digital version of this camera to capture your day old school, with the grainy and desaturated look of Super8 film. We edit this footage in to a 3-5 minute highlight film or incorporate it in to your main film.



Trash the Dress Shoot

Want to get a little crazy with your dress after the wedding? Bring along your bridesmaids, your groom, or just you and we head out to some amazing locations to get that dress covered in anything from dirt, to paint, to colored powder! The video is edited in to a 3-5 minute film.



Rehearsal Dinner Coverage

We cover your rehearsal dinner from start to finish. We film all of the little details, the food, and of course the toasts!

Same Day Film

What if you could watch your wedding highlights at your reception. With the Same Day Film we make that a reality!

While our cinematographers are shooting, our editor creates a 3-4 minute cinematic highlight of your day, shown that night at your reception! When you and your guests say, "Hey, that was me just an hour ago!" is a moment you'll always remember! This is usually shown on a large projector screen that can be provided by your venue, planner, or us.



Concept Film

Have you ever wanted to star in your own movie? Our writers come up with a short film, based on your story, with the genre of your choosing. We'll write a comedy, action film, or a romantic drama, starring you and your fiancé. We'll then shoot it, just like a movie, with everything from lights to special fx!

Slow Motion Booth

You may have seen photo booths at weddings, but this takes it to the next level. We set up a video booth, full of props and crazy costumes, then film it all with a slow motion camera. We then take all the footage and edit it in to a short and hilarious video of you and your guests!



Filmed in 4K

This option is for all the tech savvy couples. We film your wedding day in full 4K resolution, which is 4 times the size of HD. We currently deliver this as 4K digital files as well as hosting it on YouTube in 4K.

Jib Option

We bring a full size jib or crane to get beautiful wide, sweeping shots at your ceremony and reception, just like on tv.

Expedited Delivery

Our standard delivery time is within a two month period. With this option, we guarantee your delivery within one month.

Extra Cinematographer

We can provide as many extra cinematographers as you like, to capture more footage and more details. For example, we can bring in an additional person to shoot only timelapses throughout the day.

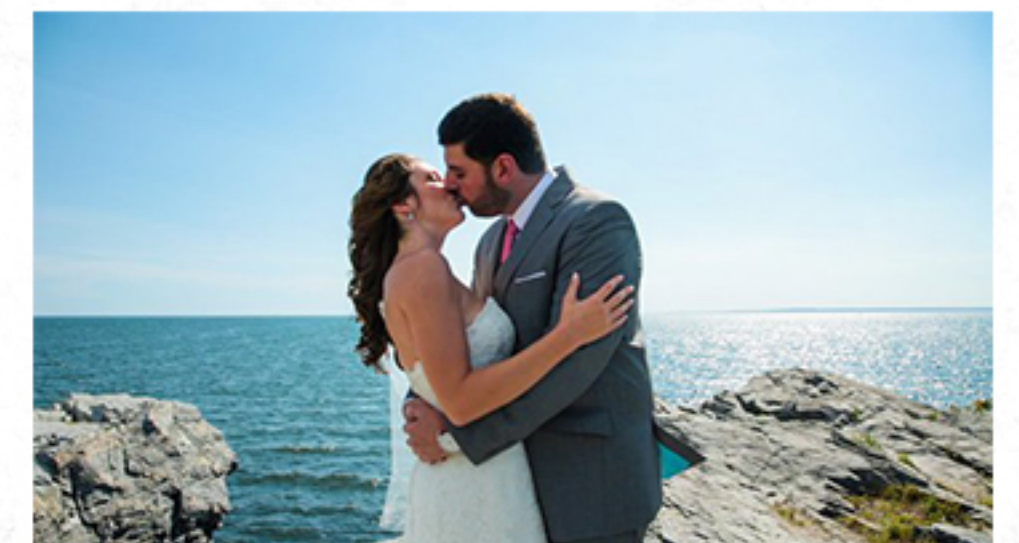
Additional Events

How did you get started filming weddings and how long have you been in the industry?

In 2004 I (Jeff, *Owner*) started working with a local photographer, filming weddings along side him every weekend. In 2010 I decided to start my own company, Full Frame Cinema. Since 2004, we've shot hundreds of weddings.

How many of your team will be shooting my wedding?

Depending on your package, there are one or more cinematographers at your wedding.

How well do you work with photographers?

We work great with photographers! We are not there to compete with your photographer, but to work together. Both of us have the same purpose, and that is to capture your wedding and give you the best experience possible!

How would you describe your style?

Our style is a unique mix between a documentary and cinematic style. We rarely ever pose or set up shots.

What parts of the wedding day do you film?

We work with you and your planner before the wedding to schedule our timeline to capture the moments most important to you. With our larger packages, we can also capture your rehearsal dinner or additional activities on your wedding weekend.

What kind of camera equipment do you use?

We use the latest in camera technology, shooting a minimum of full 1080p resolution. These cameras create a true cinematic look, with a shallow depth of field, great low light performance, and are also very small and unobtrusive.

How do you record audio for the day?

For a majority of the day we will use small on camera shotgun mics, which allow us to capture the audio up close, without being up close. For the ceremony, we mic the officiant and the groom, as well as many other small mics to capture other speakers or instruments.

How do you handle music for the wedding film and can I choose it?

Of course! Music is an incredible way to add to your film. We choose to legally license all music for our wedding films through The Music Bed (themusicbed.com) or SongFreedom (songfreedom.com) which have a diverse library of songs and scores to choose from. While we usually handle song selections, we are of course accepting of your input and choices. After all, it is your wedding video!

How do you deliver the final product?

Your final film and all the extras are delivered in multiple ways in minimum 1080p resolution. Depending on your package, it can be on blu-ray discs or a custom flash drive. Finally, we place your trailer, sde, or film online to share with friends and family.

When will I receive my final product?

Our films are delivered within a maximum of two months, but it's usually done before that. We also offer expedited delivery for an additional fee.

How do I book you and sign the contract?

Our booking process is done very simply online.

Do you use bright lights?

We have a small light that will be at the reception for toasting, cake cutting, and your first dance. We only use this light if there isn't sufficient lighting already in place at the reception. Other than that, we use no additional lighting.

Do you charge travel fees?

For our destination collections, travel is inclusive for the US. Our local collections are for Nashville and locations within a five hour driving distance. If the wedding is outside a one hour driving distance from Nashville, there will be an additional travel charge.

Is there a deposit required and what are my payment options?

A 50% deposit is require upon signing of the contract.

We accept debit card, check, or cash. There is a small fee for credit cards.

What is your cancellation policy?

Upon cancellation of a contract, we retain the 50% deposit and it is held as a credit for a future date or other services.

Do you have backup equipment?

Yes we do! We usually have several cameras, a multitude of lenses and accessories, and multiple microphones with us.

Who of your team will be shooting my wedding?

The Full Frame team has worked and trained together to provide you with the best experience and product possible. We don't contract other companies or people.

What if I want changes to my final wedding film?

We offer one round of additions or changes to your final film. After one round, additional editing fees may apply.

Do you offer the raw footage?

We offer our raw footage at an additional charge.

What do you wear to weddings?

Our team dresses professionally in all black and dark grey attire.

What can I do to make my day more "cinematic"?

There are several ways and the biggest is lighting! When planning your day, areas with as much natural light as possible provides us with the best visuals possible. Putting on your dress, makeup, or the grooms suit by a window is a great example of this. Also when planning your reception, talk with your planner about using a lighting company to add additional lighting to your reception. Another way to make your day more cinematic is to speak with your ceremony venue about using a wedding videographer. Some venues are very open to allowing us to place our cameras where necessary to achieve the best shots, while some aren't as helpful. Let them know that we are very respectful of all religious traditions and spaces and do not want to distract or take away from the event, but to provide you with the best memories possible of your day.

Additionally, audio is very important, so the ability to place a mic on the groom and officiant is essential. Speeches at your rehearsal dinner or reception also provide an incredible element to your film, so make sure they are well prepared and thought out.
